PRINCIPAL FUNCTIONS: Overview

Your role will act as an ambassador for The Pickaquoy Centre and as such you will be expected to be a dynamic member of the team who thrives in a fast paced and changing environment.

A Modern Apprenticeship in Sport and Active Leisure with the Pickaquoy Centre Trust offers candidates paid employment, with the opportunity to develop and grow their skills and knowledge to begin their career in sport and leisure industry. As part of your training, you will work across different departments, to gain a thorough understanding of the day to day operations of a leisure centre. This is a customer focused role where you will take responsibility to ensure the comfort, safety and supervision of all customers.

Main Duties

- 1. To prepare the facilities for the day to day operations.
- 2. To maintain vigilant supervision of pool, changing rooms and health suite users and ensure their safety at all times, or other areas as required.
- 3. To administer first aid, effect pool rescues and carry out resuscitation as necessary.
- 4. To carry out, and ensure, that the operational requirements of the pool is to a high standard.
- 5. To carry out daily plant and pool water treatments checks and ensure appropriate action if followed through, as required.
- 6. To support dry side operations as required, ensuring that equipment is set up and dismantled correctly.
- 7. To assist in the checking all stores as allocated ensuring that agreed standards are maintained, including the security of these stores.
- 8. To follow the reporting procedure in respect of the Centre's equipment and facilities, reporting any defects and quantity of unusable equipment.
- 9. To provide supervision and instruction in a variety of activities, such as swim teaching, coaching sports and leading children's activities.

- 10. To assist the management team in the development of the centre wide programme, as required.
- 11. To carry out cleaning duties of all areas as required.
- 12. To provide a high level of customer service.
- 13. To ensure that all tasks are undertaken in respect of the Health and Safety requirements at all times.
- 14. To assist in the continuous improvement of the Trust's quality improvement strategy.
- 15. To take part in relevant training courses and development activities as required in maintaining and improving knowledge and skills required for the role.
- 16. To follow The Pickaquoy Centre's policies, operating procedures and working instructions.
- 17. To carry any other duties as required, as appropriate to this post.
