Main Duties:

- 1. To plan, develop and coach a range of sporting opportunities for swimming-based activities.
- 2. To prepare sessions in advance, with all the necessary equipment set out and ready to receive swimmers as they arrive on poolside.
- 3. To ensure coaching sessions for both adults and children are centered, structured, progressive, fun and of a high quality.
- 4. To work with a range of user groups across all key stages as identified.
- 5. To provide a safe environment accessible to all participants.
- 6. To continually monitor and evaluate all sessions, activities and programmes and adapt future delivery to cater for differing ranges of ability.
- 7. To provide guidance on progression opportunities based on participant interest and ability.
- 8. To act as a positive role model.
- 9. To provide mentoring sessions, observations, further support, guidance and advice to other coaches where appropriate.
- 10. To work as part of a coaching team within the Trust, and to promote expansion and continuation of Trust based activities.
- 11. To abide by the UK's code of conduct for sports coaches and maintain a fair, equitable and inclusive approach to coaching regardless of the ethnicity, race, gender, religion or disability.
- 12. To attend coaching team meetings and ongoing CPD training sessions as required.
- 13. To maintain a register of users and to ensure that the necessary administration requirements are in place.
- 14. To provide an excellent level of customer service.
- 15. To ensure that all tasks are always undertaken in respect of Health and Safety requirements.
- 16. To assist in continuous improvement as measured by the Centre's scores in externally inspected Quality Improvement Schemes.
- 17. To assist with emergency procedures ensuring the safety of staff and public.
- 18. To be meticulous in your personal presentation.
- 19. To undertake any other duties as the management team may require.
